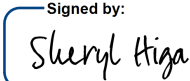

On October 31, 2025, the City was served with the complaint for Santa Clara County Superior Court case number 25CV477634, *AARON MORRIS et al vs BETTY ANNE GARDENS, L.P. et al*. The plaintiffs were tenants of the Betty Anne Gardens Apts. affected by the February 13, 2025 flooding of Upper Penitencia Creek. On March 20, 2026, the City was served with the complaint for case number 26CV489072, *First Community Housing et al vs City of San Jose et al*. The plaintiffs are the owner and operator of the Betty Anne Gardens Apts. affected by the same flooding. The City previously tendered the claims of plaintiffs to the Water District. On Feb. 13, 2025, Upper Penitencia Creek overtopped its banks west of the King Road bridge, causing flooding in multiple ground floor units of the Betty Anne Gardens Apartments, 945 Lundy Ave. in San Jose.

Santa Clara Valley Water District data shows the creek flows at the time of the flood were well below the expected creek capacity. However, a group of large trees had fallen across the creek, leading to a dam-like effect that appears to have caused the 2025 flood. The trees originated from land owned by Betty Anne Gardens L.P. Since 1983, Valley Water has held an easement to maintain the area owned by Betty Anne Gardens.

Pursuant to the Agreement for the Joint Use of Lands of Upper Penitencia Creek Park Chain by and Among Santa Clara Valley Water District, County of Santa Clara and City of San Jose, the District has agreed to indemnify the City from all claims directly or indirectly resulting from the District's exercise of flood management on the premises or from acts, omissions or activities of District Personnel.

The City has been sued by the private parties affected by the February 13, 2025 floods. The City previously tendered the claims to Valley Water. With this Claim, the City renews its tender request for defense and indemnity for the claims of plaintiffs in Santa Clara County Superior Court cases 25CV477634 and 26CV489072 based on the above-referenced contract. The City is currently incurring costs for its defense, which it will seek to recover from Valley Water through cross-complaints for implied indemnification, contractual indemnification, apportionment of fault, and declaratory relief. The City will also seek attorneys fees and costs and all other relief available in law and equity.

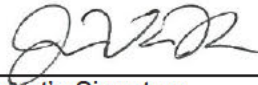

This claim is for damages to my property and families wellbeing arising from a pattern of continuous institutional negligence, ongoing nuisance, and loss of residential habitability that commenced with the initiation of the Rinconada Water Treatment Plant Reliability Improvement Project (RWTP RIP, Project No. 93294057) in 2015 and continues through the present date. This is not a claim for a single, isolated incident, but for cumulative, compounded injury caused by systemic managerial and operational failures.

****The Santa Clara Valley Water District (VW) is directly responsible for these damages due to the following historical and ongoing failures:****

**I. Historical Negligence and Loss of Habitability (2015 – 2024)**

The project, originally scheduled for approximately five years, was catastrophically prolonged due to fundamental

The damages suffered are the result of continuous, compounding tortious injury and gross institutional negligence spanning the entire duration of the Rinconada Water Treatment Plant Reliability Improvement Project (RWTP RIP), beginning in 2015 and continuing through the present date.

This claim details damages in four categories: Loss of Habitable Space, Acute Health Injury, Loss of Economic Use, and Severe Emotional Distress.

1. Loss of Residential Habitable Space (Invasion of Property Interest)

The property at 208 Granada Way has sustained a functional ****Permanent Loss of Habitable Space****, directly resulting

Dear CA Special District - Santa Clara Valley Water District,

I'm writing as a concerned Californian to ask you to take immediate action on the state's troubled 911 modernization project.

California has already invested \$450 million in a modern Next Generation 911 system that is operational today and provides critical backup protections. The state's own project records show 243 dispatch centers had passed every readiness test and were ready to go live when Cal OES paused the project. Despite this, Cal OES has handed a \$194 million no-bid contract to a single vendor — Atos — without consulting the legislature, without publishing a cost-benefit analysis, without commissioning an independent engineering review, and without identifying a backup plan if the new approach runs into trouble. Cal OES has also proposed a 31% increase to the SETNA surcharge on every California phone line, asking taxpayers to pay more before a single independent question has been answered.

This is not a responsible use of taxpayer dollars, and it is not how decisions of this magnitude should be made. The Cal OES bridge contract bypasses the kind of legislative oversight that exists precisely to prevent unilateral, sole-source spending of this size.

I urge you to support a pause on the Atos bridge contract and the broader dismantling of the current Next Generation 911 system. I also urge you to call for an independent, third-party audit to verify what the state's own records already show — that the existing infrastructure is functional, that 243 dispatch centers had passed every test, and that a wholesale replacement may not be necessary. Finally, I urge you to demand that Cal OES publish a full accounting of what has been spent to date, the justification for the sole-source contract award, and what the rebuild will ultimately cost taxpayers.

Thank you for your leadership on protecting California taxpayers and public safety.

We write to express our belief that the County of Santa Clara should fully consider all applicable labor standards in the evaluation and selection of a contractor for the Anderson Dam project, which represents a major federal investment in our region. This critical infrastructure effort provides an important opportunity to advance public safety and strengthen water resource management, while also ensuring the project is carried out by a workforce that is treated fairly, compensated appropriately, and protected under strong labor practices.

Given the scale and long-term significance of the Anderson Dam project, and its receipt of congressionally-appropriated funds, we believe that a demonstrated commitment to robust labor compliance standards is a factor that should be considered in the evaluation of contractors. Taking these steps will help safeguard the integrity of the project, support local workers and businesses, and reaffirm the joint federal and local priorities that define the project.
