

Along with meeting the program eligibility requirements listed on the [program's webpage](#), single-family properties interested in participating in the DRIP Program must provide documentation of current enrollment in an income-based eligibility program. Examples of eligible programs include, but are not limited to:

- California Tribal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
- California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKS)
- Cash Assistance Program for Immigrants (CAPI)
- California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARES)
- Food Stamps/CalFresh/SNAP
- General Assistance or General Relief (GA/GR)
- Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)
- Low Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP)
- Medi-Cal
- Santa Clara County General Assistance (GA) Program
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
- Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) Program

Income-based eligibility programs not listed will be considered on a case-by-case basis by Valley Water staff.
